- 8) The intending Bidders shall clearly understand that whatever may be the outcome of the present invitation of Bids. The tender accepting authority reserves the right to accept or reject any offer without assigning any reason whatsoever and is not liable for any cost that might have been incurred by any Tenderer at the stage of Bidding.
- 9) Prospective applicants are advised to note carefully the eligibility criteria as mentioned in NIT.
- 10) **Conditional / Incomplete tender will not be accepted under any circumstances.**

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- 11) The intending tenderers are required to quote the rate *online* per unit in INR.**
- 12)** During scrutiny, if it comes to the notice of the tender inviting authority that the credential or any other paper found incorrect / manufactured / fabricated, that bidder would not be allowed to participate in the tender and that application will be rejected without any prejudice.
- 13)** The General Manager reserves the right to cancel the N.I.T. due to unavoidable circumstances and no claim in this respect will be entertained.
- 14)** If there be any objection regarding prequalifying the intending firm may contract SWL within 2 (*two*) days from the date of publication of NIT.
- 15)** Before issuance of the ORDER, the tender inviting authority may verify the credential and other documents of the lowest tenderer if found necessary. After verification if it is found that the documents submitted by the lowest tenderer is either manufactured or false in that case order will not be issued in favour of the said Tenderer under any circumstances.
- 16)** Escalation of Price on any ground and consequent cost overrun shall not be entertained under any circumstances. Rates should be quoted with a minimum validity of 120 days.

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SECTION - A
INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

General guidance for e-Tendering:

Instructions / Guidelines for electronic submission of the tenders have been annexed for assisting the contractors to participate in e-Tendering.

- i. Registration of Contractor:
Any firm willing to take part in the process of e-Tendering will have to be enrolled & registered with the Government e-Procurement System, through logging on to <http://etender.wb.nic.in>.
- ii. Digital Signature certificate (DSC):
Each firm is required to obtain a Class-II or Class-III Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) for submission of tenders from the approved service provider of the National Informatics Centre (NIC) on payment of requisite amount. Details are available at the Web Site stated in Clause A.1. above. DSC is given as a USB e-Token.
- iii. The interested firm can search & download N.I.T. & Tender Document(s) electronically from computer once he logs on to the website mentioned in Clause A.1. using the Digital Signature Certificate. This is the only mode of collection of Tender Documents.
- iv. Submission of Tenders:
Tenders are to be submitted through online to the website stated in Clause A.1. in two folders at a time for each work, one in Technical Proposal & the other is Financial Proposal before the prescribed date & time using the Digital Signature Certificate (DSC). The documents are to be uploaded virus scanned copy duly Digitally Signed. The documents will get encrypted (transformed into non readable formats).

Technical Proposal:

The Technical proposal should contain scanned copies of the following in one cover (folder).

Statutory Cover Containing the following documents:

- 1> **N.I.T.**
(NIT downloaded properly and upload the same Digitally Signed). The rate will be quoted in the B.O.Q.
Quoted rate will be encrypted in the B.O.Q. under Financial Bid.
- 2> **Prequalification Application**
There must be uploaded Eligibility of firms mentioned on NIT.

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Tender Evaluation Committee (TEC)

Evaluation Committee constituted by the Competent Authority of SWLLTD will function as Evaluation Committee for selection of technically qualified contractors.

Opening & evaluation of tender:

Opening of Technical Proposal:

Technical proposals will be opened by the Concerned Tender Inviting Authority or his authorized representative electronically from the website using their Digital Signature Certificate (DSC).

Cover (folder) for Statutory Documents will be opened first. If there is any deficiency in the Statutory Documents the tender will summarily be rejected.

Summary list of technically qualified tenderers will be uploaded online.

Pursuant to scrutiny & decision of the Tender Evaluation Committee the summary list of eligible tenderers & the serial number of work for which their proposal will be considered will be uploaded in the web portals.

During evaluation the committee may summon of the tenderers & seek clarification / information or additional documents or original hard copy of any of the documents already submitted & if these are not produced within the stipulated time frame, their proposals will be liable for rejection.

1. Financial Proposal

The financial proposal should contain the following documents in one cover (folder) i.e. Bill of Quantities (BOQ). The contractor is to quote the rate online through computer in the space marked for quoting rate in the BOQ. Only downloaded copies of the above documents are to be uploaded virus scanned & Digitally Signed by the contractor.

If any tenderer fails to produce the original hard copies of the documents like Completion Certificates and any other documents on demand of the Tender Evaluation Committee within a specified time frame or if any deviation is detected in the hard copies from the uploaded soft copies, it may be treated as submission of false documents by the tenderer and action may be referred to the appropriate authority for prosecution as per relevant IT Act.

Award of Contract

The Bidder whose Bid has been accepted will be notified by the Tender Inviting & Accepting Authority through acceptance letter / Letter of Acceptance.

The notification of award will constitute the formation of the Contract.

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SECTION - B

Special Terms and Conditions

- (i) **Scope of Supply:** Scope of supply & technical specification as stated above.
- (ii) **Terms of Price:** Quoted price shall be firm and fixed till full execution of order and shall be on F.O.R. SWL, Howrah basis. Price per set to be offered inclusive of delivery charges upto SWL Yard.
- (iii) **Taxes:** Taxes and or any other charges as applicable are to be mentioned clearly.
- (iv) **Terms of Payment:** 90% against delivery of materials at SWL Yard. Balance 10% on submission of Performance Bank Guarantee [PBG] (as per SWL's format) of equivalent amount from Nationalized Bank valid for contractual guarantee period.
- (v) **Delivery Schedule:** Within 60 (sixty) days from the date of receipt of P.O.
- (vi) **Inspection:** By Q.C. Dept. of The Shalimar Work (1980) Ltd. after receipt of materials at yard.
- (vii) **Guarantee:** The materials are to be guaranteed for satisfactory performance for the period of 18 (eighteen) months from the date of supply and acceptance. Any defects arising within the guarantee period towards manufacturing and performance are to be liquidated forthwith, by replacement, if required. Manufacturer's Test Certificate & Guarantee Certificate are to accompany the supply.
- (viii) **Commissioning:** Commissioning of the Engines on board are to be done at SWL Yard free of charges.
- (ix) **Liquidated Damage (L.D.):** For delay in delivery of materials, L.D. will be applicable @0.5% per week or part thereof on the undelivered materials / work subject to maximum 5% of the order value.
- (x) **Risk Purchase:** In case of delay in delivery beyond the contractual delivery period, SWL shall have the right to cancel the order and procure items from alternative sources at Vendor's complete risk and cost.
- (xi) **Force Majeure:** Standard Force Majeure conditions at the seller's own workshops/establishment shall only be accepted. The failure of the Sub-contractors of the seller will not be accepted as the Force Majeure conditions. Force Majeure occurrence notice will have to be given within 7 days of Force Majeure for a possible delivery extension after verification.
- (xii) **Arbitration:** For disputes arising in executing and discharge of the contract from either side the Managing Director. The Shalimar Works (1980) Ltd. 4, Garden Reach Road, Kolkata – 700023 shall act as Arbitrator between the Seller & Buyer.
- (xiii) **Courts:** The contract is deemed to have been entered into Kolkata and all courses of action in relation to this contract will therefore be deemed to have arisen within the Jurisdiction of the Kolkata Courts.
- (xiv) **Validity of Offer:** Offer must be kept valid for 90 days from the date of tender opening.
- (xv) This tender is being issued without any financial commitment and SWL reserves the right to change, delete or amend the quantity of goods, at any stage during execution the order. SWL reserves the right to withdraw this tender or reject any or all offers, if so necessary, at any stage without any reference to the bidders.
